ACC Outdoor Pool Policy

- **Mission, Vision, and Purpose**

1. **Mission:** To provide a safe, inclusive enriching aquatic environment for all tribal members and visitors.
2. **Vision:** A pool that fosters community wellness, respects tribal protocols, and promotes lifelong healthy habits.
3. **Purpose:** To ensure the safety, cleanliness, and enjoyment of the pool and swimmers.

- **Pool Hours**

1. **Open Swim:** 3:00 PM – 7:00 PM Tuesday to Friday (subject to change)
Rec, SALC, and EDU use the pool until 3pm
2. **Open Swim:** 12:00 PM – 6:00 PM Saturday and Sunday (subject to change)
3. **Closed:** During maintenance, inclement weather, or emergencies.

- **Access & Eligibility**

1. Pool use is **restricted to Enrolled Senecas, Descendants, other tribal members living on territory, and residents of an 8 mi radius (This will cover Vandalia, Carrollton, Killbuck, Salamanca City/Town, Little Valley, Redhouse, and Steamburg.)**
2. This will include the playground, the pool area and its surroundings.
3. Residents must show proper ID.
4. **All** pool users must sign in at the ACC front desk before going to the pool.

- **Fees to Swim**

1. Non enrolled Seneca community members, fees \$1.00 ages 0-12, \$3.00 ages 13-17, and \$15.00 adults, \$5.00 elders.
2. Enrolled Seneca, Seneca Descendant, and other tribes living on territory, it is Free to use the pool. We encourage you to sign up for a free membership at the ACC to streamline this process.

- **Safety Rules**

1. Respect Lifeguards at all times.
2. Lifeguard **must** be on duty to swim.
3. Children under the age of **13** must be accompanied and supervised by an adult (over the age of 18).
4. No running, diving, rough play, or foul language.
5. Glass containers are prohibited.

- **Hygiene & Attire**

1. Proper swimwear required (no street clothes in the pool).
2. **Showers are a must** before entering the pool.
3. Infants/toddlers must wear swim diapers.
4. Please do not enter the pool if you have had any recent illnesses, including diarrhea, skin infection, other contagious conditions or open wounds/sore

- **Food, Drinks & Smoking**

1. Food is not allowed in the fenced in pool areas.
2. No alcohol/drugs use or be under the influence.
3. Smoking/vaping prohibited in/near pool area. (includes tobacco/marijuana)
4. Lifeguards and ACC staff reserve the right to inspect any bag, cooler, or backpack upon entering the pool area.

- **Respect & Courtesy**

1. Keep music at a reasonable volume.
2. No reserving chairs with unattended belongings.
3. Follow lifeguard and ACC staff instructions promptly.

- **Enforcement**

1. Lifeguards **are authorized** to eject anyone that violates the safety rules.
2. Violations of the safety rules may result in suspension of pool privileges.
3. The Seneca Nation and ACC Director reserves the right to amend rules for safety and enjoyment.

- **Operational Procedures**

1. **Opening/Closing:** Daily checklists for equipment, water quality, and safety gear performed by lifeguards and ACC staff.
2. **Maintenance Schedule:** Regular cleaning, chemical testing, and equipment servicing done by SNI Facilities.
3. If the lifeguards need assistance they should radio into the building, call management, or call SNI Marshals, utilize 911 for any medical emergency.
